Erica Rodrigues Viegas holds a degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences from the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Lisbon (FFUL) (2003) and is a specialist in Hospital Pharmacy certified by the Portuguese Pharmaceutical Society (2011). She was member of the Council of the College of Hospital Pharmacy and of the Jurisdictional Council of the Southern Regional Section and Autonomous Regions of the Portuguese Pharmaceutical Society.

Between 2012 and 2022, Erica Rodrigues Viegas has been the Coordinator of the Pharmaceutical Services at Hospital de São Francisco Xavier, part of the Western Lisbon Hospital Centre (CHLO), E.P.E.

A pharmacist since 2003, she began her career in the Pharmaceutical Services of Hospital de São Francisco Xavier. Throughout her professional journey, she has held several technical and managerial roles, notably: Technical Secretary of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, member of the Antimicrobial Prescribing Support Group, the Quality and Safety Committee, and the Local Coordination Group for Infection Prevention and Control and Antimicrobial Resistance. She was also a member of the Risk Management Committee (2010–2017), Quality Manager of the Pharmaceutical Services (2009–2018), and a member of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee at Hospital de São Francisco Xavier between 2003 and 2006.

In parallel, she has collaborated with the National Oncology Registry (RON) and has been a Guest Lecturer at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Lisbon (FFUL) since 2014. She is also a member of the Research Ethics Committee for Human Studies (CEISH) at FFUL since 2018.

With a strong commitment to continuous professional development, she has completed several advanced training programmes, including the Specialisation Course in Hospital Administration at the National School of Public Health (on going); the Hospital Pharmacists' Management Programme (Nova SBE – Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Health, 2018); the 3rd Postgraduate Course in Hospital Pharmacy (2005–2006); the Advanced Management Programme for Pharmacists – PAGEF (Portuguese Catholic University, 2004); and the 34th Joaquim Bonal Clinical Pharmacy Course at Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau, Barcelona (2007).

She is the author and co-author of around 30 scientific poster communications presented at national and international congresses and scientific meetings, as well as publications in scientific journals and book chapters.
